



Uniform Policy & Dress Code

****Anything not listed in the Uniform Policy or in violation of the Dress Code is not permitted.*** Parents/Guardians will be contacted to bring your child a change of clothes if deemed necessary.

The purpose of the school Uniform Policy and Dress Code serves a number of purposes. Firstly, it fosters a greater sense of school identity and belonging to a community. Additionally, uniforms reduce fees otherwise spent on school clothing costs. As a Christian school, we believe our dress code reflects the simplicity and modesty of living a Christian lifestyle. Finally, uniforms provide for less decision-making in the morning, promoting greater assurance of an on-time school arrival.

Girls Uniform:

- **JUMPERS or SKIRTS:**
 - St. Sebastian approved plaid jumpers or skirts from Lands End.
 - For 2018-2019 school year only:
 - Navy blue skirt/skort worn no higher than 4" above the knee, not rolled or unzipped.
 - Navy blue, red, white, or powder blue polo dresses (one piece, solid color)
- **PANTS or SHORTS:**
 - NAVY blue long dress pants - free of rips and/or holes, nor cuffed or rolled at the ankle.
 - NAVY blue tailored uniform shorts or navy blue capris may be worn seasonally, weather-permitting.
 - If pants or shorts have exposed belt loops, a belt should be worn.
- **SHIRTS:**
 - Logo free or Sebs uniform logo red, white, navy, powder blue polo shirts (short/long sleeved), blouses, or turtlenecks.
 - Uniform shirts are to be tucked in to students' skirts, pants, or shorts during all instructional time.
 - A plain white t-shirt may be worn under the uniform shirt as long as it is tucked into one's skirt, pants, or shorts.
- **SWEATERS/SWEATSHIRTS:**
 - Sebs approved uniform logo OR logo-free red, white, navy, light blue sweater/vest or cardigan may be worn over the uniform shirt (no hoods).
 - A plain white t-shirt or a collared shirt of uniform color may be worn under the uniform sweater or sweatshirt as long as it is tucked into one's skirt, pants, or shorts, or does not exceed the length of the sweater or sweatshirt.
 - *Spirit wear logo may be worn on Fridays or non-uniform days only.
- **SOCKS/TIGHTS:**
 - Plain red, white, navy, black or white socks, no-shows, knee-highs or tights, worn at all times.
 - Socks may also have a small, single logo (Nike swoosh, Adidas stripe, ex.). No-show socks are acceptable.
- **LEGGINGS:** Solid red, white, navy, or black leggings may be worn under uniform skirts/dresses.

Boys Uniform

- **PANTS or SHORTS:**
 - NAVY blue long dress pants - free of rips and/or holes, nor cuffed or rolled at the ankle.
 - NAVY blue tailored uniform shorts may be worn seasonally, weather-permitting.
 - If pants or shorts have exposed belt loops, a belt should be worn.
- **SHIRTS:**

- o Plain or Sebs logo red, white, navy blue, or powder blue (short/long sleeved) polo shirts, Oxford button down, or turtlenecks
 - o Uniform shirts are to be tucked in to students' pants or shorts during all instructional time.
 - o A plain white t-shirt may be worn under the uniform shirt as long as it is tucked into one's pants or shorts.
 - **SOCKS:**
 - o Socks must be plain red, white, black or navy.
 - o They may also have a small, single logo (Nike swoosh, Adidas stripe, ex.). No-show socks are acceptable.
 - **SWEATERS/SWEATSHIRTS:**
 - o Sebs approved uniform logo OR logo-free red, white, navy, light blue sweater/vest or cardigan may be worn over the uniform shirt (no hoods).
 - o *Spirit wear logo may be worn on Fridays or non-uniform days only.
 - o A plain white t-shirt or a collared shirt of uniform color may be worn under the uniform sweater or sweatshirt as long as it is tucked into one's pants, or does not exceed the length of the sweater or sweatshirt.
 - **TIES** (optional): Uniform-approved ties through Lands End may be worn with a uniform-colored Oxford button-down shirts any school day and/or for mass day dress (Wednesdays).
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ST. SEBASTIAN "SPIRIT DAY FRIDAYS": Every Friday - unless otherwise specified - students and staff may dress for "Spirit Day Fridays". Any St. Sebastian top may be worn, showing one's school spirit, including but not limited to: sports teams, extra-curricular activities, parish or Faith Formation involvement, and spirit wear with our logo. Any top worn (jackets, fleece, shirts, sweatshirts) must note "St. Sebastian" somewhere on it (or an approved variation of the school name) or our logo. Uniform bottoms are to be worn, along with all other uniform dress code requirements.

Additional Dress Code Expectations:

- **JEWELRY:**
 - o Stud earrings alone are allowed
 - o A single necklace with a Christian symbol (small crucifix, cross, saint medallion) may be worn
 - o A watch, medical ID bracelet, and/or a limit of two bracelets may be worn
- **HAIR:**
 - o Hair should be neat and clean. Hairdos and/or haircuts bordering on the extreme are not permitted.
 - o Only natural hair coloring is permitted.
 - o This is determined by administration. If questions, please ask ahead of time.
- **HAIR ACCESSORIES:**
 - o Hair accessories worn must be functional and not ornamental, not large in size, nor costume-like.
 - o For long hair, accessories must be used to keep one's hair out of one's face for learning purposes.
 - o Hair ties, headbands, & small accessories must be school uniform colors: navy, red, black, white, or of a natural hair color.
- **FOOTWEAR:**
 - o Proper footwear should be worn every day. For days students have PE class, tennis shoes must be worn.
 - o Light-up or shoes with wheels are not permitted.
 - o Sandals (with backs) with socks are allowed as appropriate weather permits on uniform days.
 - o Dressy sandals without socks are permitted for dress-UP days only, weather permitting.
- **MAKE-UP:** No makeup or tattoos are allowed, unless permitted for a Spirit Day.

Dress Code for Out of Uniform Days:

- Clothing styles and length must match the uniform policy - shirts must have sleeves, at least 2 inches thick.
 - leggings may be worn, only if a student's bottom is completely covered throughout the school day by a top.
 - No pajama pants, leggings (worn as pants), or lounge wear—unless indicated for Spirit Days
 - Clothing must be in good repair—no distressed, ripped, torn clothing is permitted.
 - Clothing is to be modest (not tight-fitting or revealing) no rips or holes and must have sleeves.
- A phone call home will be made for an exchange of clothes to be brought to school if dress is deemed inappropriate.
